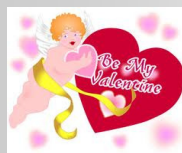
FROSTBITE OPEN - FEBRUARY 4, 2012

MONTHLY UPDATE FROM SUPERINTENDENT

Greetings Wildwood Green Members.

The January weather has been very mild and kind allowing the maintenance team to advance on several projects. So far over 40 railroad ties have been installed along cart path edges and high traffic areas. Woodchips and mulch are being applied along tree line areas and wooded areas are being thinned out.

Our 1st phase of cart path paving is now complete. Upcoming for the month of February you will see more railroad ties installed along with continued mulching of tree line areas. Sand trap depths will also be inspected and sand added where needed. Our first aeration is scheduled for the end of March and I will provide additional updates in the March newsletter.

Golf got its name because all of the other four letter words were taken.

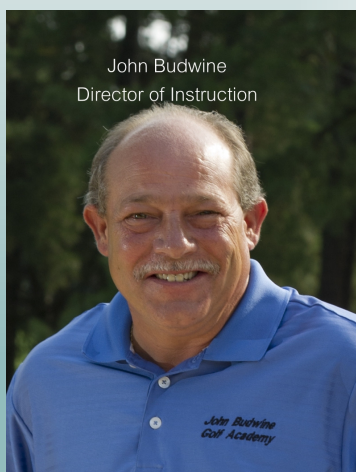
