July will be a busy month for events! In 2011 we have brought back the parent-child event. This is set for **Sunday July 10th** starting at 5:00 PM. This will be a 9 hole Superball event for parents and children. Grandparents are permitted and one person must be a member of Wildwood Green. Cost is \$20 plus any applicable cart fees (walking is permitted). Flights will be broken up by the age of the child playing. Entry includes range balls, dinner after play, trophies to the winners and closest to the pin for parents as well as the juniors. Be sure to sign up for this event quickly as it is sure to fill up fast!

On **Monday July 11th** we will be hosting a senior event open to men and women both members and non-members. Participants must be 60 years or older and have an established handicap. This event will start as a 9:00 AM shotgun and the format is Four Person Superball. Teams will be made by the Golf Shop following an A, B, C and D format. Entry includes green fees, range balls, gift certificates to the winners and a sandwich buffet following play. Cost: \$35 guests; \$30 members riding; \$15 members walking or members on the cart plan.

The second of four Men's and Ladies Package Events will be hosted on **Saturday July 16th**. This event will start as a 9:00 AM shotgun with lunch after play. The format for this Package Event is 1 Gross Ball plus 2 Net Balls.

Teams will be made into foursomes following an A, B, C, and D format. Remember to save money by signing up early! The entry fee is typically \$25 but if you pay before the day of, it is only \$20. We are still offering a prepay special...The prepay special is a total of \$50 and covers the entry fees into the last three Package Events. By pre-paying you will save \$25 off of your entry fees for the rest of this year!

Sunday the 24th will mark July's Couples Event. The event will be four person teams, Captain's Choice format. The Couples Event starts at 5:00 PM and we will serve a delicious dinner after play is over. Entry fee is \$20 and does not include the cart fee (walking is permitted in the Couples Events).

Greens, however, have done much better this year. The dethatching that was completed at the beginning of June has proved to be a key to success. Several cultural practices

that are scheduled for the summer will be frequent light top-dressings, hydroject aerification and we will be reinstalling fans on #9 and #3. You will also see the maintenance team out hand watering greens more as the summer progresses. A fairway and tee aerification that was much needed was also completed in June. Some of the

weaker fairways and tees will be aerified again and several fertilizer applications will be made. We have also added sod to collars and tees and more is scheduled. 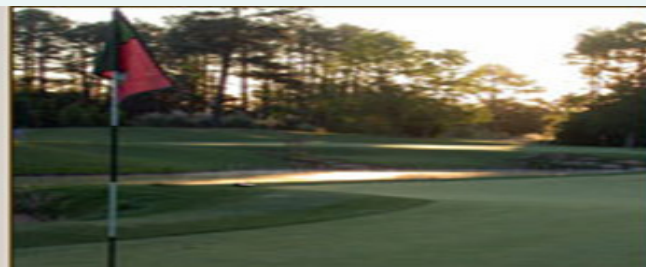
