June will mark an outstanding month for Wildwood Green. We will be hosting our annual Member-Guest golf tournament, The Battle at Ballybunion, from June 24th-26th. The festivities will kick off Friday the 24th with a par 3 shootout and a pairings party. At this time the pairings will be announced and the participants will be allowed to get their tee gift. Tee times on Friday are available for an included practice round and times have been blocked from 8:00-8:30, 10:30-11:00 and 12:00-12:30 on Friday specifically for the participants. The event will tee off as a 9:00 AM shotgun start, both Saturday and Sunday. The first round's format will be nine holes of Modified Alternate Shot and nine holes of Captain's Choice. The second round will be Best Ball Gross plus Best Ball Net and may be the same ball for both scores. The event will conclude with a fabulous lunch and awards ceremony on Sunday the 26th. The Club is a top class Links course founded in 1893 and the host to the Murphy's Irish Open in 2000 and the Palmer Cup in 2004.

## MONTHLY UPDATE FROM SUPERINTENDENT

Greetings Wildwood Green Golf Club members. Many members have mentioned the putting surfaces have improved over the past months. I am confident that with the months to come the putting surfaces will continue to improve. The maintenance team will be dethatching putting surfaces on May 31<sup>st</sup> and June 1<sup>st</sup>. This process allows water and air to penetrate the soil profile. This cultural practice aids with ball roll and increased overall speed of the putting surface. In

addition, topdressing applications are critical with smoothness and speed. There will be light topdressing applications made throughout the summer months.

In addition, several areas of sod have been installed over the last month. The lady's tee and collar on hole #12 along with the men's tee on hole #2. The maintenance team will be sodding areas on #4, #11 and #13 over the weeks to come.

A fairway and tee aerification has been scheduled

for the second week of June. The reason for this process is soil compaction. When compaction is reduced, water and air are allowed to penetrate the soil profile allowing roots to become healthier. A fertilizer application will be completed in parallel to aerification, improving overall turf quality. 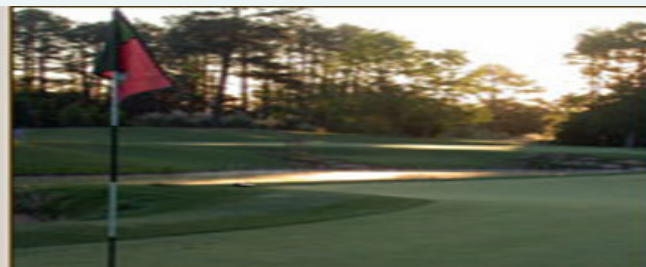
